Emergency & Safety



1. In Case of Emergency:

- Follow the tour guide's instructions promptly.
- Evacuation routes and muster points are clearly marked.

2. First Aid: Basic first aid is available on board. Contact the nearest staff member if you require assistance.

1. Safety Precautions:

- Always hold on to railings or stable structures while moving around, as the boat may shift suddenly due to external factors such as waves, wind, and other vessels' wakes.
- Be cautious on exterior decks, which can become slippery when wet from sea spray or rain. Walk carefully to avoid accidents.

2. Footwear:

- Only wear soft-soled shoes, socks, or go barefoot on deck to protect the special wooden flooring. High heels and shoes with sharp edges are prohibited.
- Always watch your step and avoid rushing or running, which can lead to collisions, slips, or trips.

3. Hazardous Objects: If you notice any sharp objects on the deck, remain where you are and alert a crew member immediately for assistance.

Safety Equipment

Handling Safety Gear: Do not touch or interfere with safety equipment (such as lifejackets, life rings, fire extinguishers, etc.) unless there is an emergency. The crew will provide instructions and distribute equipment as needed.

noking Policy

No Smoking: Smoking is strictly prohibited onboard to prevent fire hazards. This includes preventing cigarette ends from being carried by the wind into flammable areas.

🙁 Intoxication

Prohibited Behaviour:

 For safety reasons, passengers must not be intoxicated or under the influence of drugs while onboard. If a passenger appears intoxicated, we will stop serving them alcohol. 杨守

Lightning

During Thunderstorms:

- In the event of lightning, avoid touching metal surfaces or rigging. Move towards the centre of the vessel for safety.
- If lightning becomes severe, the crew may guide passengers to the below deck for protection.





A Crew Instructions:

- Follow all instructions given by the Captain and crew promptly and courteously. They are there to ensure your safety and enhance your experience
- Do not interrupt the crew when they are handling ropes or sails.
